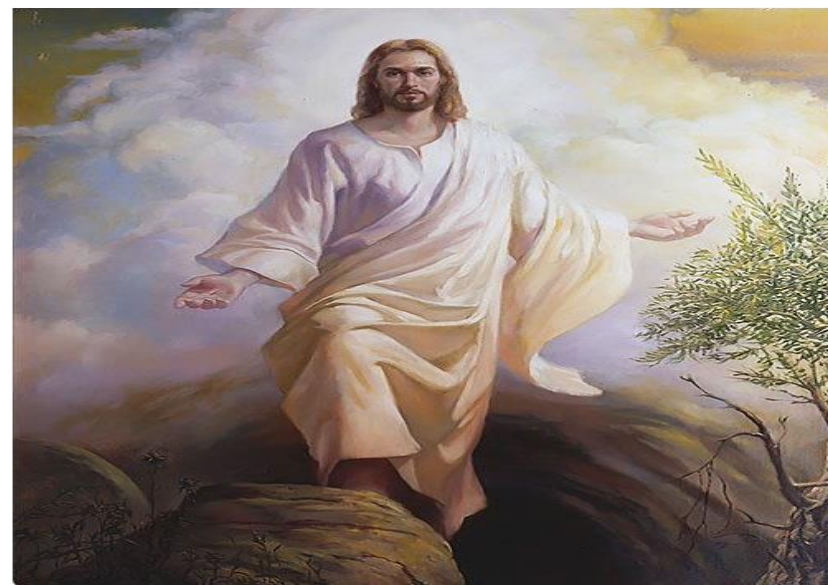

Parents and godparents must attend a baptismal preparation meeting beforehand. The next preparation course for Baptism will take place in the parish, date to be confirmed.

This course is for those who are new to Ignatian spirituality, from any background. Its focus is primarily on Ignatian ways of prayer, within which we come to know more about the God who created us, who we are and who we were made to be. Just as there are a great variety of physical exercises for increasing our physical health, St. Ignatius believed that what he called the Spiritual Exercises would develop **our spiritual health, our relationship with God and the world.**

### **World Apostolate of Fatima Event**

The WAF England and Wales National Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima and the Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco will be at Westminster Cathedral on **Saturday 21st April 2018, from 14.00 – 16.00.** This event will include a Procession of the National Pilgrim Virgin Statue and the Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco from Our Lady's Chapel to the Sanctuary, the recitation of the Rosary, Marian hymns, and talks by Fr Richard Nesbitt, the WAF diocesan Spiritual Director for Westminster, and Fr Jason Jones, the WAF National Spiritual Director. There will also be the opportunity to be Enrolment in the Brown Scapular, and this will be followed by exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction. The afternoon will conclude with a general blessing with the Relics of Saints Jacinta & Francisco (no individual veneration) and a Procession of the Statue and the Relics to St Paul's Chapel.
