The Ascension of the Lord

Today we celebrate the feast of the ascension and we hear Luke's account of Jesus leaving the disciples, his final words and gestures to them. Jesus' departure does not cause the disciples to be anxious, instead we are told that they return to Jerusalem and praise God in the Temple. For Luke, this is a celebration of the mission to come. Luke's Gospel begins in the Temple and there it ends in anticipation of the Church's mission, a mission that was meant to be rooted in prayer and service we might pray these words of St Teresa of Avila Today:

Christ has no body now but yours, No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which he looks compassion on the world. Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good. Yours are the hands with which he blesses all the world.'

WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY ASCENSION SUNDAY, 12TH MAY 2013

Every year on the Sunday before Pentecost the Church celebrates the achievements of the communications media and focuses on how it can best use them to promote gospel values. What is it? World Communications Day was established by Pope Paul VI in 1967 as an annual celebration that encourages us to reflect on the opportunities and challenges that the modern means of social communication (the press, motion pictures, TV, internet, etc.) afford the Church to communicate the gospel message. So, on this day we are encouraged to pray for communications professionals and there will be a second collection for the Catholic Communications Network (CCN), which is entirely funded by this collection.

Q. Ages ago you wrote in our Newsletter that Mass is a rehearsal of heaven. I have often meant to ask you to say more about what you meant.

A. It is only the full beatific vision of God in heaven that the perfect praise of God can take place. The wonder of the Eucharist is that we are invited to do this in memory of Jesus', that is, to lift up our hearts in joining with him in his return to the door of death, into his resurrection and ascension. We offer all honour and glory to the Father through Jesus (as the Mediator between earth and heaven), with him (as brother in our humanity) and in him (as members of his Body). Therefore, what happens at Mass is an anticipation of the perfect praise which belongs to heaven.
