This means that the government will top up your offering by **25p for every £1** at no extra cost to you, the giver. SPOTLIGHT ON THE MASS

Over the next 6 months, we'll be focusing on a part of the Holy Mass in our newsletter; this week: The Gloria.

The main text of the Gloria is from Scripture—the angelic song revealed to the shepherds at the birth of Christ. It gives glory to God, who forgives us our sins. This angelic hymn is an ancient Christian hymn of thanks, praise and triumph for redemption and hasn't really changed for 15 hundred years. The Gloria has two primary sections: In the first part, we praise and thank the Heavenly Father who has revealed in creation and throughout salvation history His glory to His people. In the second part, the hymn focuses on Jesus not only as the Lamb of sacrifice but also as the triumphant Christ. The Gloria ends with a Trinitarian acclamation. Ultimately, after having acknowledged our sins during the penitential rite, the Gloria is our heartfelt response to the fact that God has forgiven us our sins out of love for.
