This is why I am drawn to reread on a frequent basis Henri Nouwen's book, 'The Return of the Prodigal Son: a homecoming.' It is the daily challenge to love as God loves, and to accept to love ourselves as God loves us.

A father-figure is one who makes a positive and constructive difference to a person's life. Do we need to recognise this about selves, or to notice where we have received the gift of fatherhood on the journey?
